- Adequate coverage of thematic priorities




WP 2017 has been assessed against these criteria





HP 2014-2020 Objectives coverage (%) -AWP 2017



ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

- EU Member States;
- Iceland and Norway;
- Serbia and Moldova

(countries which have a bilateral agreement with the European Union, in accordance with Article 6 of Regulation (EU) No 282/2014 on the establishment of a third Health Programme for the Union's action in the field of health (2014-2020))





European Commission co-funding

- 60% of the total eligible cost
- 80% if exceptional utility

New: There is the obligation for each applicant to contribute equally to the action' s budget

Financial contribution to the functioning of non-governmental bodies (operating grants)

Call for proposals will be organised for the conclusion of fouryear framework partnership agreements (FPA) covering years 2018 - 2021

In particular, but not limited to, the following priority areas:

- Prevention and health determinants,
- chronic diseases, cancer, dementia, rare diseases,
- HIV/AIDS, Tuberculosis, Hepatitis,
- access to healthcare, and
- substances of human origin.

About the programme

On 21 March 2014, the <u>Third Health Programme</u> was published in the Official Journal of the European Union and is <u>available in all EU official languages</u>.

The programme has 4 overarching objectives:

- Promote health, prevent diseases and foster supportive environments for healthy lifestyles taking into account the 'health in all policies' principle
- Protect Union citizens from serious cross-border health threats
- Contribute to innovative, efficient and sustainable health systems
- Facilitate access to better and safer healthcare for Union citizens

The Third EU Health Programme with a budget of \in **449.4 million** is the main European Commission instrument to implement the <u>EU health strategy</u>.

It is implemented by means of **annual work plans** which set out priority areas
